

2024-12-11 Report No. 35/2024: Polish Financial Supervision Authority decision on changing the buffer of other systemically-important institution.

Further to current report no. 28/2024 of 17 September 2024, the Management Board of ING Bank Śląski S.A. ("Bank") hereby communicate that on 11 December 2024 the Bank received a decision from the Polish Financial Supervision Authority ("PFSA") on changing the buffer of other systemically-important institution determined for the Bank. In line with the principles adopted by the PFSA, the adequate value of the buffer was determined as the amount equivalent to 1.0% of the total risk exposure.

The PFSA decision means that the buffer of other systemically-important institution for the Bank shall be changed from 0.5% to 1.0%.

Legal grounds: Article 17.1 of Regulation (EU) No. 596/2014 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 16 April 2014 on market abuse (MAR).
